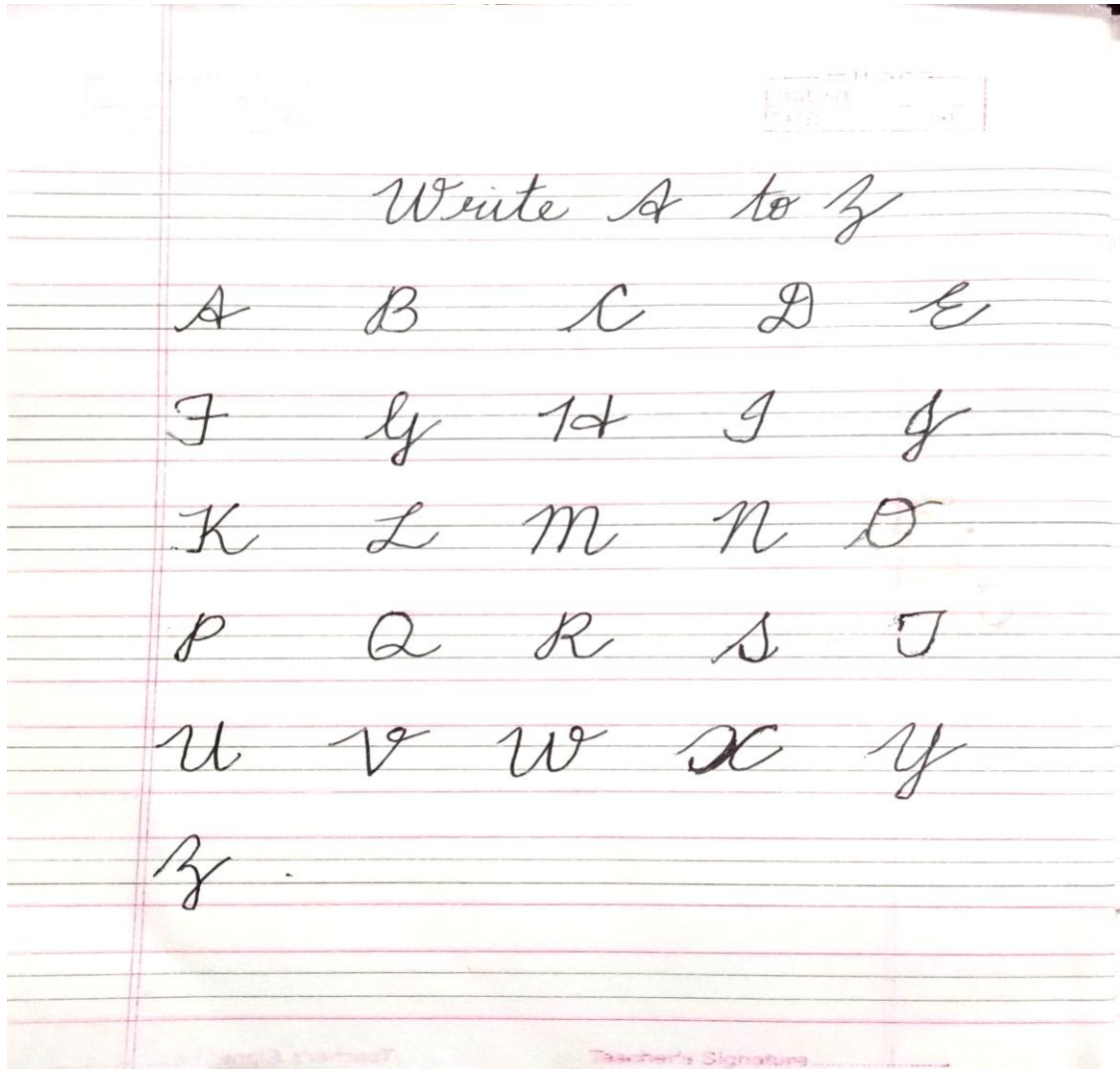

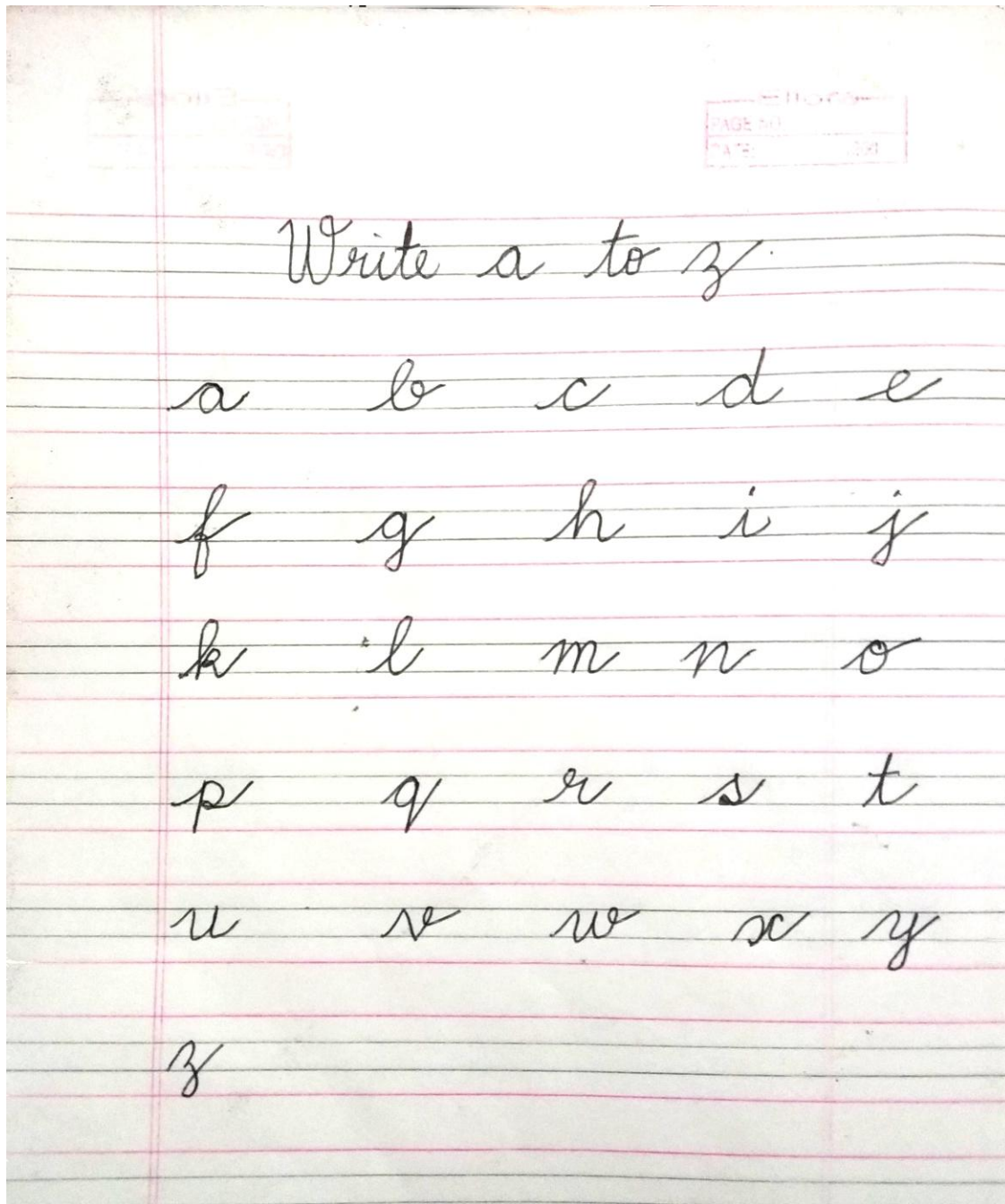

3. Write small cursive a to z. (As shown below)

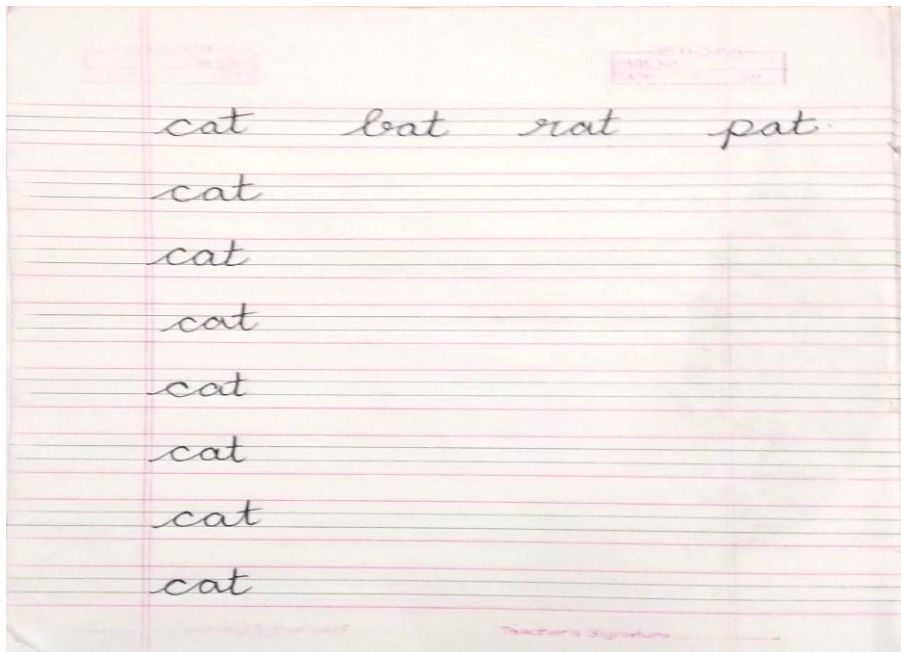


4. Write the following words in the English Literature copy.

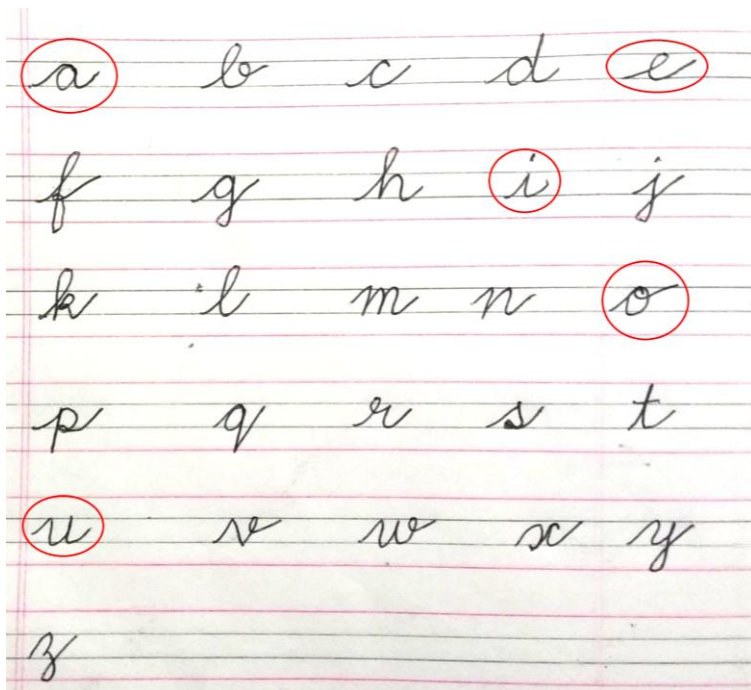
