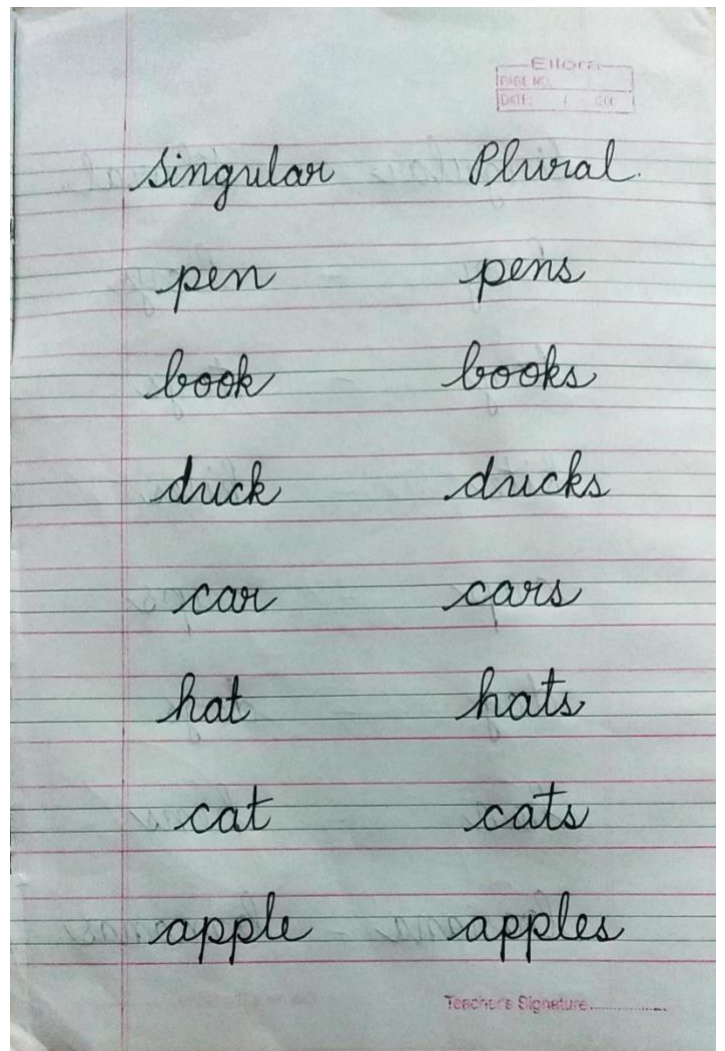
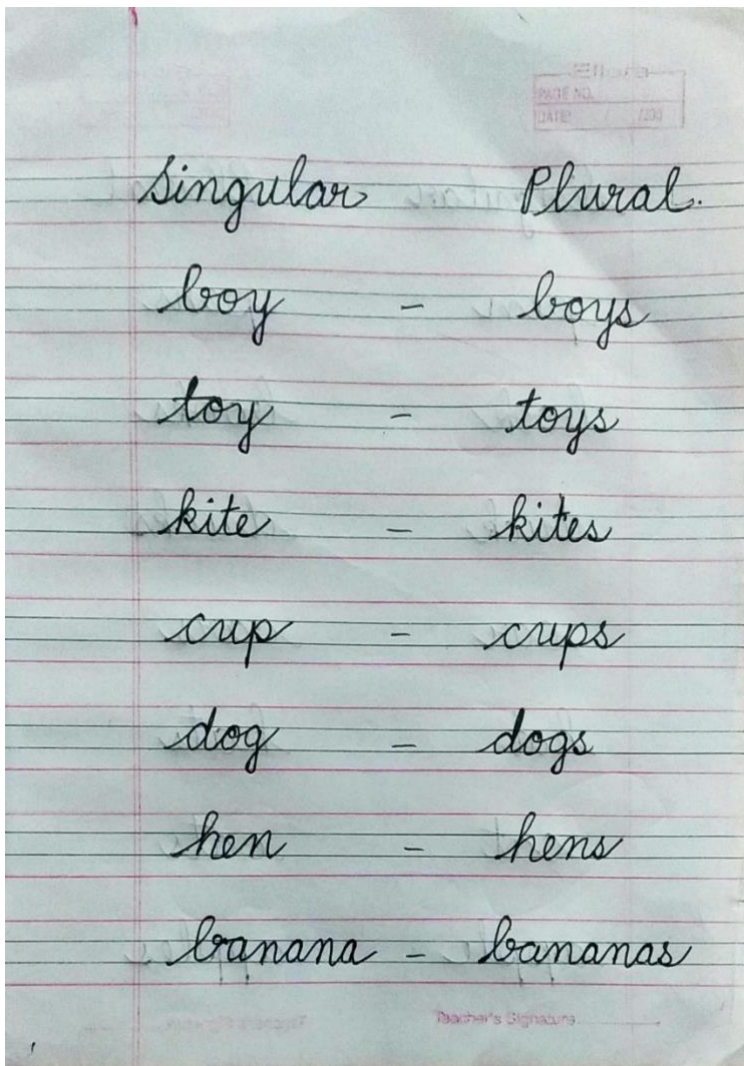


Class – UKG

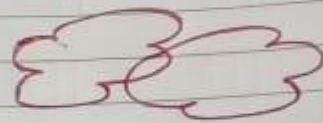
